What You Need to Get Your Goods

An Appointment

Your probably guessed this. Let's move on.

Documents and Payment

To enter Green Goods you must have the following things on your person:

1. A signed certification from a doctor
2. A Medical Marijuana Card from the Pennsylvania Department of Health
3. At least one ID with your picture on it
4. A form of payment – we accept cash, debit cards, or CanPay

Health insurance does not cover medical marijuana, and we can not accept credit cards.

SUPER IMPORTANT: you have to bring all of that stuff every time you visit.

It's not a one-time thing, it's every single time forevermore.



IF YOU HAVE A CAREGIVER:

A caregiver who is registered with the Pennsylvania Medical Marijuana program can pick up your medication for you at the store or accept it at your home. But you can't just say "Oh, yeah, that person's my caregiver." They have to register and have their Pennsylvania Medical Marijuana Caregiver Card on them in order to pick up your goods. You can have up to 2 registered caregivers. If a friend or family member who is not a registered caregiver would like to come with you for moral support or vicarious living, they must show a government issued photo ID.

What Happens at Your Appointment?

The first thing to do on your first visit is to chat with the pharmacist. They'll help you pick the product and format that will work best for you. You'll also talk about dosing and any potential interactions or side effects. That conversation will probably last about 30 minutes, but if you two really hit it off and want to keep talking about movies or sports or politics, that's totally up to you.
